

Grade 10 - Day 2: Match the halves - Group A and Group B

Matching worksheet, no cutting needed. Group A uses page 2, Group B uses page 3. The beginnings are numbered 1-10 in the left column; the endings are mixed up (a-j) in the right column. Students draw a line or write the letter next to each number, then read the full sentences aloud and give the Uzbek meaning of the bold word. Groups swap sheets for a second round.
